We now have progeny from both our 2015 and 2017 shipments and are very excited about the results we are getting from using our range of Snowmass males over our Celtic Triumph females.

Rugosa Park— Established in 2006, we had the advantage of starting with already advanced breeding stock. We continue to carefully select for fine, dense, long stapled & robust alpacas suitable for commercial quality fleece production.

Towarri Alpacas—Established in 2004 in the Upper Hunter. Our aim through the SRS breeding program is to increase density, fibre length, and crimp definition which leads to low micron and higher fleece weights. We have achieved this by using sires such as Towarri Artic Star and Forestglen Battle Hymn, and have now purchased Glenhope Hugo who has a follicle density of 68. Our main lines are whites and light fawns but we also have an interest in breeding a small number of quality coloured animals.
